COMPETITION RULES

- 1. New Partner. Competitors must have a different partner for each evening and will be judged on the best three results from four competitions. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided from the highest score on any evening, cascading, if necessary, to the second highest score and so on.
- 2. Soutar Trophy will be judged on the best four results from six competitions. In the event of a tie the winning pair will be judged from the highest percentage score.
- 3. King Trophy. As Flowers Trophy but must include at least 1 member of different gender.
- 4. Trophy Competitions. Members partnering visitors will not be eligible for a trophy.
- 5. Open Pairs. Orb Paquot Trophy and Pip and Mary Barber Trophy are awarded to the gentleman and lady respectively achieving the highest percentage score in a pairs evening, who otherwise have not won a trophy during the season. In the event of a tie for highest score the winner will be decided on the second best score.
- 6. John McEldon Trophy. Same gender partnerships will be eligible for the trophy but will be split up if all male and all female partnerships simultaneously appear.
- 7. Caplan and John & Jane Baker Trophies. As the John McEldon Trophy but same gender partnerships will not be eligible for either trophy.
- 8. The Jewson Cups will be run as a normal Pairs event with the Top Ladies pair winning the Ladies Trophy and the top Mens pair winning the Mens Trophy.
- 9. All competitions will take place commencing 6.45 pm promptly at Norfolk Snowsports Club, Trowse, unless otherwise stated. Members are requested to be seated by 6.35 pm.
