Bidding – Lebensohl part 1

This is the first of two seminars explaining the benefits of Lebensohl. You open 1NT and the opponents intervene. Using Lebensohl allows you to differentiate between forcing, invitational and non-forcing hands and to show hands with or without a stop in the enemy suit.

Each seminar includes an introduction followed by some practice hands and discussion. The aim is to give you the tools to enable you to bid accurately after your opponents have disturbed your 1NT bid.

This seminar is suitable for Intermediate players and for more experienced players who have no knowledge of Lebensohl.
