This is the second of two seminars explaining the benefits of Lebensohl. The first dealt with dealing with interference over our 1NT opening. This extends the principles learnt to other situations: it is particularly useful when the opponents open a weak two and we make a take-out double. Using Lebensohl allows you to distinguish between strong and weak hands.

The seminar includes an introduction followed by some practice hands and discussion. The aim is to give you the tools to enable you to bid accurately after opponents have opened a weak two.
