

Two Suited Overcalls

Hands with two long suits have a lot more playing strength than their point count suggests and when your opponents have opened the bidding in one of the other suits, a two-suited overcall can often be very effective as a pre-emptive weapon. But when should you use them? And what should you do when it's your partner who makes one?

Focussing on two widely used conventions – the Unusual No Trump, and Michaels Cue Bids – this seminar will describe how they each work, helping you to recognise when you have the right kind of hand to make a two-suited overcall, and decide how to respond to one made by your partner. You'll also learn some tactics you can adopt to counter a two-suited overcall made by the opposition.
