## *Information for competitors*

### **Swiss Pairs**

Is a form of duplicate bridge that tends to match pairs of equal ability against each other, so it makes an enjoyable event for players at all levels. Our event will work like this:

- During the day, you play six short matches of six boards, each match against a different pair.
- For the first match, your opponents are randomly drawn. All tables play the same six hands. At the end of the match each hand is scored up by the computer as a percentage in the normal duplicate way, and then your score for the match is converted to a “Victory Point (VP) score” out of 20, depending how well or badly you did in that match compared with everyone else.
- For your next match, you are assigned to play against a pair with the same or nearly the same total VP score as yourselves, and so on through the day. Thus, after the initial match, you always play another pair who are doing approximately as well (or as badly!) as you are.
- The winners at the end are the pair with the highest total VP score.
