Declarer Play - Making more tricks in suit contracts

This is the first of a series of seminars that are aimed at club players who have got past the beginner stage and want to improve. Each seminar includes a led discussion of sample hands followed by some practice hands. The aim is to show the sort of thinking that is natural for experienced players.

This seminar looks at four ways to make extra tricks in suit contracts:

1. Cross-ruffs – when you don't draw trumps but try to make trump tricks in both hands by ruffing
2. Dummy reversal – when you ruff with the longer trump suit and draw trumps with the shorter suit
3. Elimination and throw in – when you make defenders open up a side suit for you
4. Coping with poor trump suits and bad breaks in the suit.
