The contract is 6D played by South. West leads A♥, followed by the 5♠. How does South make 12 tricks?

1. South wins the second trick with A♠, and draws one round of trumps with the A♦ in dummy.
 2. Declarer then plays the K♥ from dummy and discards the K♠ from his own hand.
 3. 6♦ now makes by a cross ruff. Declarer making 12 tricks with one spade, one heart, two clubs, one diamond when he draws a trump, and seven other diamonds by the cross ruff.
