

The contract is 6D played by South. West leads A ♥, followed by the 5 ♠. How does South make 12 tricks?

- 1. South wins the second trick with $A \spadesuit$, and draws one round of trumps with the $A \spadesuit$ in dummy.
- 2. Declarer then plays the K♥ from dummy and discards the K♠ from his own hand.
- 3. 6 ◆ now makes by a cross ruff. Declarer making 12 tricks with one spade, one heart, two clubs, one diamond when he draws a trump, ,and seven other diamonds by the cross ruff. Well played South.
