Information for Applicants

- 1 Complete every part of the applicant's section of the form. Write "None" or "Not known" where appropriate.
- 2 Get your proposer and seconder to sign their section of the form, giving their names in BLOCK CAPITALS.
- 3 Hand the form to a Committee Member, who will sign and date it and post it on the notice board in the hall.
- 4 After a minimum of seven days on display the application will be considered at the next Committee meeting. The Committee will normally vote on your application at that meeting and the Membership Secretary will write to you. This procedure may take a month or two, or even longer if, as occasionally happens, the Committee defers consideration until after the applicant has played a session of bridge with a member of the Committee. However, while an application is under consideration, table money is charged at the Members' rate.
- 5 On election to membership you will be asked to pay the joining fee together with your subscription for the current year. Membership takes effect on receipt of your payment and thereafter the annual subscription falls due for payment on 1st January.
- 6 Please note that our usual means of contact with members is by email unless they indicate otherwise, or do not have this facility.
- 7 A reasonable standard of play is required of any applicant, together with knowledge of British bidding systems.
- 8 A respectable manner of dress and personal hygiene is expected at all times from Members and from visitors.
- 9 All Members and visitors are required to behave in a manner commensurate with the EBU's "Best Behaviour at Bridge" policy. Bad behaviour contrary to this policy will not be tolerated, and could lead to exclusion from membership.
- 10 No Member can propose or second another applicant unless he/she has been a Full Member for at least one year.

Guidance should be sought from a Committee Member if you have any questions on the above.
