The main item on the agenda was the suggestion from EBU that the SCBA might undertake the Organisation of the EBU's Riviera Congress. After much discussion and after a follow up call to Gordon Rainsford on the following day it was decided that because the event had to be held at a seaside venue at the start of July this only left the Winter Gardens as a viable space and a) the WG was not available on those dates and b) it was felt that to organise an event relatively close to the West of England would impinge negatively on our event it was decided not to accept the invitation.

- 2. To purchase a refurbished dealing machine as back up and a new printer as the old one was not performing well.

Frank reported that only two teams had entered the championship teams of four. Paul was asked to send out a mailshot encouraging more entries and the deadline was extended until the end of October.
