Prizes: Wine for highest % or IMP score for each session (no more than once!); cash prizes will be awarded to at least the top 10% in each event; and the winners of each event will be presented with trophies. Non-expert prize in the Swiss Pairs.

Green Points are awarded in accordance with EBU scales. Bonus green points will be awarded to the leading pairs & teams at the appropriate EBU scale.

Licensing: The congress is licensed by the E.B.U. Level 4.

Refreshments: Before play food and drink can be purchased in the bar near the entrance to the hotel. For meals between sessions please see overleaf for the menu at the hotel. Orders have to reach me and be paid for by 14th April. There are many other eating places in Telford.
