Q: Can the dummy call the director?

A: Yes and No. According to Law 9, when an irregularity as occurred (such as a revoke etc.) dummy may not draw attention to it during the play but may do so after the play of the hand is concluded. However, any player, including the dummy, may summon the director AFTER attention has been drawn to the irregularity!
