

1. When you go to a table or new players are coming to your table, greet them, give them your name and ask theirs if they don't have a nametag.
2. Smile, be pleasant. Stop talking about the last hand from the round before.
3. Count your cards, preferably in your lap. If you count them on the table and a card is face up or flips, it is now an exposed card and you need a Director's call.
4. Remember to lead your card face down on the table and ask "any questions". This is to prevent a lead out of turn. After the card is tabled and the "any questions" is answered, the card is played and cannot be picked up and replaced by another card.
5. At the end of the hand, make sure everyone agrees on the number of tricks won or lost before picking up your cards. Give them a brief shuffle before putting them back in the board.
