RUSSELL ALLAN Obituary

Dr. Robert Russell Allan, known as Russell, passed away peacefully on 11ith December 2016, aged 86. Russell was a Grand Master and played at Farnham BC, and at RAE until it closed. He had been playing bridge at a high level for many decades.

Russell was part of the winning team in the Hubert Phillips Bowl in 1973.

He was also part of Surrey's winning team in the Pachabo Cup in 2000. Together with other teammates from Farnham BC, they won the Lady Rose Cup in 1999-2000, and the Lady Rose Plate in 1996-97. He was a member of Farnham BC's winning teams in the SCBA Teams of 8 competitions of 1998-99 and 1999-2000, and was a member of the team that won the Surrey Bowl in 2005-06.

Russell, together with Penny MacLeod, Keith Wilson and Graham Davison, won the Surrey green pointed Swiss Teams event in the autumn of 1997.
