Event Details

★ In this **Bracketed KO** format, all teams will play a Swiss Team Qualifier for the first 2 sessions on the first day to determine which teams will advance to the KO phase on the second day. Directors will assign teams to brackets to make them as fair as possible.

KO and Swiss Teams consist of 4-6 players. Teams must play in both sessions, or until knocked out.

All Pairs events are two session; single entries will be available.

Gold Rush Pairs: no individual player may have more than 750 MPs.

0-299er Pairs: no individual player may have more than 300 MPs.

All events are stratified by average MPs. A/X/Y events: open/3000/1500; Gold Rush events: 750/500/200; 0-299er events: 300/200/100. Stratification may be changed by the Director-in-Charge. Bracketed events with only one bracket may be handicapped. All events subject to entries.
