

# WHAT DOES THE SCORER NEED FROM THE DIRECTOR?

## 1. SCORER IS AN ASSISTANT TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR.

---

Law 80 - The Tournament Organizer's powers and duties include:

- (g) to arrange<sup>27</sup> for the appointment of any assistants required for the Director
- (j) to arrange<sup>27</sup> for scores to be collected, results tabulated, and an official record made of them.

<sup>27</sup> It is normal in some jurisdictions for the Director to assume responsibility for some or all of the tasks that the Tournament Organizer is here required to arrange.

## 2. IN THE BEGINNING...

---

New players at the club?

The movement. Certainty! If in doubt wait, until near the end of the first round if necessary.

Number of tables.

Movement description (Howell, Mitchell, No of Rounds, Boards per round)

Is there a missing pair? If so where?

Time per board\round

Clock running or controlled by Director?

## 3. WHEN IT GOES WRONG...

---

Support and keeping the pressure off.

## 4. IN THE MIDDLE...

---

Checking suspicious scores

Advise scorer of any anomalies – eg screen not updating or missing player names

Where adjusted scores are required, instruct players to enter contact as 7NT taking 1 trick (so it is obvious to Scorer)

## 5. AT THE END...

---

Details of adjusted scores

Checking suspicious scores

## 6. AFTERWARDS...

---

Details of any corrections to scores
