Afternoon 1.30 – 5.00 ESTABLISHING SUITS/TAKE OUT DOUBLES

In this interesting session you will learn how to establish long suits in trump contracts, by handling your entries carefully. Tricks with twos and threes will materialise as if by magic. After the tea-break, Andrew will be illustrating just how useful Double can be and you will play some very instructive deals that result.

Evening 6.30 – 10.00 SHOWING YOUR SHAPE/WHICH CARD TO LEAD



The key to bridge is shape. You will learn how to show your precise shape in the bidding, enabling your partner to choose the correct contract – then will come the challenge of making it. After the tea-break, there will be a very useful and eye-opening session on the defence, focusing on which card to lead, primarily when switching after seeing dummy than the opening card.

The cost is £11.50 per session (£12.50 for non-members) which includes tea/coffee, and an excellent supper is available in the interval at a cost of £6.50 per person.
