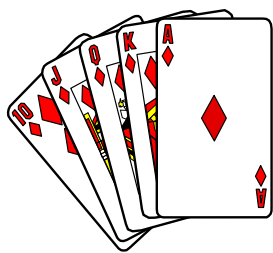
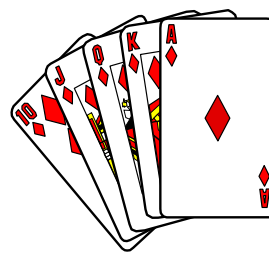


# WORCESTERSHIRE CONTRACT BRIDGE ASSOCIATION



## The Worcestershire Leagues



**Think the social aspect of Bridge is important?**  
**Want to play some afternoon games?**  
**Want a competitive but friendly game?**  
**Want to play in a welcoming environment?**

If the answer to any of the questions above is "Yes", then think about entering a team into one of the Worcestershire Leagues. The matches are played in one of the players' homes and, subject to agreement, can be played at any time of the day (or night!). The atmosphere is friendly, the bridge is (usually!) of a good standard and there is the opportunity to discuss hands of interest afterwards or at half time.

As well as the bridge, the matches usually provide an opportunity to socialize with your own team and your opponents. The result is a thoroughly enjoyable evening or afternoon – or sometimes both if you get on well with your opponents!

The mechanics are that we have 3 divisions in the Open League and an increasing number of divisions in the No Fear/Beginners Leagues, each consisting of about 6 teams. So you will play one match a month, on a date agreed between the teams, over the winter months. Each match consists of 24 boards (with the option of 20 boards in the No Fear & Beginners divisions). The host team provides refreshments, which may be taken at half time or at the end of the match. Teams may consist of up to six players to help to avoid arranging dates becoming a burden.
