2	Minutes of the last Meeting The Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 26 February 2014 were taken as read and agreed.	
3	Matters Arising from previous meeting The committee considers the lighting in SGC is now adequate and the new carpet has been laid. DNP has spoken to Mike Rafferty about the arrangements for the Mitchell Salver competition next year, in order to be sure that improvements will be introduced. It has been confirmed that, as there were more teams than expected, the competitions will be run over 3 weekends next year (Corbett Cup and Plate, Mitchell Salver, Corbett Cup and Plate finals).
