2	Minutes of the last Meeting The Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 23 April 2014 were taken as read and agreed.	
3	Matters Arising from previous meeting	
	HP is to discuss the use of Pianola software with Jan Titcombe.	HP
	Bank mandate forms are in the process of being completed.	DH/DNP/ DP
	David Lightfoot has kindly offered to review the BNBC constitution, in relation to membership rules. It is intended that changes will be proposed at the next AGM.	HP
	The committee agreed the following new rules for the Ladder competition next year, to try to make the competition as fair as possible and to encourage pairs competing in the ladder to play on normal club evenings: - pairs would only be able to win a prize in the Ladder if they had both attended a minimum of 16 times throughout the year, - the ladder would continue to be played over 10 months with the best 8 scores being counted, - there would be no arrow switch so E/W and N/S pairs would each be given scores from 15 down to 1, with their scores being merged into one list over the year.	
	The committee discussed the feedback from the recent Cut-in teams' event. It was agreed that future teams' events would be improved if the director gave an explanation about how the event would work and also if time was allowed for teams to get together at the end to review their scores.
