## About the HCL International Bridge Championship

Bridge is a strategy game that teaches one to be of a tougher mindset, to use one's intellect to maximum capacity, communicate powerfully, and to pursue victory diligently. It is these qualities that make Bridge a perfect fit for HCL.

HCL has been strongly supporting the game in India since 2003 through the HCL International Bridge Championship held every year in New Delhi, India. The Championship is the premier Bridge tournament in the country and the biggest in terms of prize money and participation levels. The 2018 Championship had a prize purse of ₹ 18 million and witnessed participation from over 850 players from 162 teams. International teams having players from USA, Poland, Italy, Bulgaria, Russia, Netherlands, Israel, Sweden, Iceland, South Africa, UK, Australia, New Zealand, Croatia, Denmark, Romania, Japan, Thailand, Jordan, Sri Lanka, and Bangladesh have participated in the last two editions of the Championship.

The $17^{\text {th }}$ HCL International Bridge Championship will be held from August 5-10, 2019 at the JW Marriott Hotel in Aerocity, New Delhi. The total prize money is ₹18 Million (USD 250,000), one of the highest across any Bridge tournament worldwide. The championship will have three main events:

- Team of Four Gold - Winners will be awarded the 'Naresh Tandan Trophy'
- Team of Four Sliver - Winners will be awarded the 'Mohini Tandan Trophy'
- Open Pairs - Winners will be awarded the 'Neena Bonarji Trophy'

This year onwards, we are also adding another event - "Team of Four Bronze" to encourage newcomers to the game.

Note 2 There are two prizes each in the Best Mixed and Ladies Pairs categories of the Open MP Pairs event. For this, pairs must reach the Open MP Pairs final or 3rd elimination of the MP Pairs event.

## Entry Fees

- Team of Four Gold - ₹ 10,000 for 4 member team and $₹ 1,500$ for additional member
- Team of Four Silver - ₹ 7,000 for 4 member team and ₹. 1,000 for additional member
- Team of Four Bronze - ₹ 5,000 for 4 member team and ₹ 1,000 for additional member Note: In the Team of Four Gold and Silver events, the 16 teams qualified to play the KO stage will pay an additional ₹ 3,000 per team, whereas for the Bronze event, the 8 teams qualified to play the KO stage will pay an additional ₹ 2000 per team.
- Open MP Pairs - ₹ 4,000 per pair
- Open MP Pairs Strata II - No entry fee for this event if the pair has played in Open Pairs as partners. For new entries, entry will be ₹ 1000 per pair.
- IMP Pairs - ₹ 2,000 per pair
- IMP Pairs Strata II - ₹ 1000 per pair

Note: There will be a $50 \%$ concession on entry fee to a team / pair consisting of all under- 30 players.

## Important notes for the participants:

- In the Silver event, a team can have only one "National Master" level player. A player above the rank of "National Master" will not be allowed to participate in the Silver event.
- All foreign teams will participate in the Gold event only, unless the tournament committee allows them to participate in other categories.
- For participation in the Bronze event, a team can have maximum 2 players with a maximum of 200 Total MPs (Federation \& Local inclusive) to their credit and the remaining players should not have more than 100 Total MPs.
- Tournament Committee has the rights to reject a player's entry to the Bronze event, in case it is found that the player is experienced enough in the Bridge circle but wants to participate in the category just because he / she is fulfilling the 0-200 MPs criteria.
- The Bronze event will be played only if there are a minimum of 24 teams participating in the event. In case the number is less than 24 , the participating teams of the Bronze category will be merged with the Silver event and no separate prizes for the Bronze event will be given.
- The MPs to be considered for participation in the Silver and Bronze events will be as on 31st July, 2019.
- This year onwards, the Top 26 pairs from Elimination-3 round of MP Pairs will qualify for MP Pairs Gold final, whereas pairs ranked $27-52$ will play in the MP Pairs Silver final. The rest of the Elimination-3 qualifiers will be seeded to the IMP Pairs final.
- No entries for team events will be accepted after the stipulated closing time of 2000 hrs . on Friday, August 02, 2019.
