Special Games Thursday, June 22 – 0-299 section and Open section

Please join us for the first 0-299 section and open section on a trial basis The open section will be on the left as you enter the main door and the 0-299 section will be on the right, close to the coffee. Please fill the tables starting from 1 to help us determine the size and configuration of the sections.

The 299er game will be stratified into three strats 0 to 50, 50 to 100 and 100 to 299. This is based on the average of the two players. No player with more than 299 can play in this game.

This game will allow players with under 300 masterpoints the opportunity to play with players at their own masterpoint level.

The game will run **monthly** at first and either increase or decrease in frequency, dependent on participation. The masterpoint level may be changed based on feedback from the players ie 0 to 199.

Players with less than 300 masterpoints will still be welcome to play in the open game.

Should I play in this game:

YES: Even with the friendly atmosphere of Duplicate Lite; some players are intimidated playing in the open section. Chances of winning are improved. The game will mean playing at your own level. And your chances for masterpoints should improve if you are in the 0 to 50 or 100 to 300 groups. Players in the 50 to 100 range are already favoured to win in the 0 to 100 strat in the open game.

NO: Wanting to improve quickly; here you have more chances of playing against more advanced players (and beating them:))
