Ethical play is the foundation of duplicate bridge. We are continuing to monitor play but we need your help to report any unusual occurrences during our games where you may have encountered suspicious bids or play of the hand. Please report any such incidents to BBO and our directors.

We all like to receive compliments. Of course, we encourage you to compliment the opposition and your partner. However, it may be best to compliment your partner in private chat. Sometimes you have done well because the opposition has made an error and when you compliment your partner, you are not being kind to the opposition. So make plenty of compliments at the table (on Table chat) to the opposition but perhaps save the compliments for your partner on private chat. At the end of the round, click your partners name and you can access private chat.
