Type of movement: Two tables, 2 rounds, two 13 board rounds, share boards on each round.

Round 1 Table 1 - NS (team A) remains, EW (team B) goes to EW (enter numbers in bridgemate)

Table 2 - NS (team B) remains, EW (team A) goes to EW (enter numbers in bridgemate)

Round 2 Table 1 - NS remains, EW (team B) goes to NS on table 2

Table 2 - EW remains, NS (team b) goes to EW on table 1

Type of movement: 4 Tables – Circulation, 27 Boards

Starting positions:

Round 1 Table 1: 1NS v 2EW, Table 2: 2NS v 1EW, Table 3: 3NS v 4EW & Table 4: 4NS v 3EW

Round 2: Team 1 v Team 3 and Team 2 v Team 4.

Round 3: Team 1 v Team 4 and Team 2 v Team 3.

Set out boards: Two boards are set out first 3 tables and three on table 4.

The nine boards circulate round all four tables. After completing the 9 boards

there is a score-break before introducing the next 9 board set.

Type of movement: 6 Tables – Thurner, 25 Boards

Set out boards: 5 sets of 5 boards on tables 1 to 5

Table 6 shares with Table 1 on first round, and subsequently with other tables

Starting positions: EW pair from team n goes to table 8-2n or 13-2n

ie EW1 to 6, 2 to 4, 3 to 2, 4 to 5, 5 to 3 & 6 to 1

Board movement: Down one table round circuit 5 to 1

Shared boards must be returned to lower-numbered table

EW pair movement: Pairs 1 through 5 EW move up one table round circuit 1 to 5;

on the round when they would arrive at their Home Table,

they play at Table 6 instead and share boards with their Home Table.

Pair 6 EW moves up two tables at a time round circuit 1 to 5

and shares boards with Table 6.

Type of movement: 8 Tables – Thurner, 28 Boards

Set out boards: 7 sets of 4 boards on tables 1 to 7

Table 8 shares with Table 1 on first round, and subsequently with other tables

Starting positions: EW pair from team n goes to table 8-2n or 13-2n

ie EW1 to 8, 2 to 6, 3 to 4, 4 to 2, 5 to 7, 6 to 5, 7 to 5 & 8 to 1

Board movement: Down one table round circuit 7 to 1

Shared boards must be returned to lower-numbered table

EW pair movement: Pairs 1 through 5 EW move up one table round circuit 1 to 7;

on the round when they would arrive at their Home Table,

they play at Table 8 instead and share boards with their Home Table.

Pair 8 EW moves up two tables at a time round circuit 1 to 7

and shares boards with Table 8.
