## Standard responses to 1 NT

1. With $5+$ cards in a major suit; any strength:
2. Otherwise, with 4 cards in either or both Majors; 11+ HCP:

1. As a rescue to a Minor:

7+ cards in a Minor; < 7 HCP:
2. As a Game invitation:
< 4 cards in either Major; 11 or 12 HCP:
Problem with the Game invitation:
If Opener has 13 HCP, should she Pass or bid 3 NT

## An alternative approach

## Use 2 for:

Either 1) Rescue to a Minor; still with 7+ cards in a Minor and < 7 HCP
or $\quad$ 2) A Game Invitation with exactly 11 cards; $<4$ cards in either Major and 11+ HCP
Use 2 NT for:
A Game Invitation with exactly 12 cards; < 4 cards in either Major and 11+ HCP

## Opener's Re-bid

| Responder's bid | Opener's strength | Opener's Re-bid |

## Responder's second bid after 2 \& first response
