Treasurer's Report

As a result of cost savings on catering Rodger now expects a financial result equivalent to 2017/8. The proposal to change the HBA financial year to enable more accurate accounts was agreed and will be put to the AGM for approval.

Tournament Reports

- Following feedback from the Clubs meeting in January the Tournament Sub Committee had
 met. It was agreed to change the entry criteria for Cadet events and also the Eccles Cup. The
 Victor Ludorum criteria were also proposed to be changed.
- The changes at the Welwyn venue have meant that the new building is not ideal for HBA events. New venues will be sought for as many competitions as possible for the 2019/20 season.
