

K.C.B.A. EDUCATION OFFICER'S REPORT

COMMITTEE MEETING

JANUARY 8TH 2018

1. Due to unforeseen personal circumstances all bridge matters had to be put on hold for the last 6months of 2017. I hope now to resume my work for the Kent Committee and put into operation the plans I had, but was unable to develop until now.
2. In addition I was not able to attend the EBED teacher's congress in the autumn as I had hoped. As I had been invited to present a paper on how we have developed our teaching programme at Folkestone I was very disappointed to miss this opportunity. However I have had feedback from EBED which suggests it was very successful and Jack Reason from Canterbury attended. I plan to meet up with him to get more information on the particular issues that were discussed.
