Dummy (N) held:    ♦K10832

Andrew (S) held:    ♦J974

The defenders' *joint* cards were A-Q-6-5.

How would you play?

Playing for oppo cards to divide 2:2 with ♦A on his left, Andrew led ♦J. LHO put in ♦5 and Andrew rose with ♦K, winning. Any ♦ lead now sets up 3 more winners. As the full deal (*below*) shows, AR guessed right "on the day".

Smiling for your *Oxfordshire Bridge* editor, he modestly confided, "It's nice when it works. Doesn't always."
