On behalf of Bridge on the Edge ("BOTE"), it is my pleasure to present the Alzheimer Society of Newfoundland and Labrador, Inc. with a donation of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00), representing funds collected this past week during BOTE's Longest Day fundraising campaign.

Our donation consists of 23 checks totalling two thousand, six hundred and forty-five dollars (\$2,645.00) and currency totalling one thousand, three hundred and fifty-five dollars (\$1,355.00) in the following denominations:

Accompanying this letter and contribution are three pledge forms, an enlarged auction in-kind donation record, and an auction – buyer record with the bid sheets and description placards for the twelve items in our silent auction. We asked for complete contact information from all donors (except, of course, those wishing to remain anonymous). While not all entries are complete, I believe every entry is sufficient to identify the donor and provide a tax receipt. If you feel any of the entries are insufficient, please let me know.

On the what we designated pledge form 3, two donations were stricken out with a notation indicating the donation was withdrawn at the donor's request. These donations were intended

as partial payments toward a winning bid for one of the items in our silent auction. When we informed these donors that the winning bidder already paid the full bid price for the item, these donors asked for their donations to be returned, and we accommodated them.

Regarding the silent auction, the entries on the in-kind donation record and the bid sheets description placards for the silent auction are ordered to correspond with the list you received from us earlier. Entries on the auction – buyer record were made in the order payments were received, and we used the “EMAIL” column to enter the item number from the in-kind donation record. We trust this is satisfactory.

Finally, BOTE’s members were advised they could make Longest Day contributions online, and I understand several members did so. Last August 7th, you sent BOTE a letter recapping BOTE’s Longest Day efforts and providing a grand total for the amount BOTE raised during the 2018 campaign. I would appreciate BOTE receiving a similar letter for the 2019 campaign, with any BOTE online contributions included in the grand total.

Let me close by acknowledging the people who did the work behind this donation. The members of BOTE’s Longest Day Committee — Shakti Chandra, Laura Flynn, Marylou Leeman, and Madonna Wadden — spent many hours preparing BOTE’s silent auction table, staffing our donations table, answering questions, writing receipts, and, in general, making BOTE’s Longest Day campaign a great success. I would also like to thank Marilyn Bennett, Richard Lash, and Janet Parsons for devoting their time and talent to the supervised play fundraiser. Additional thanks go to those who donated items for BOTE’s silent auction and to those who purchased them. These individuals were acknowledged by name during BOTE’s Thursday afternoon game, and they are identified on the enclosed auction donor and buyer records. Last, but not least, thanks go to Richard Comerford, the BOTE officer who reviewed our collections and verified them against our supporting documentation.

It was BOTE’s pleasure to contribute to your organization and help your cause. We pray for a cure, and, until a cure arrives, we stand with you.
