The Victor Ludorum

The following events are qualifying events for the award of VL points:

- (i) The championship pairs
- (ii) The championship teams
- (iii) All stand-alone one day events that have no restriction on entry :- The Mixed Teams, Swiss Teams, Paul Jones, Ladies and Men's Pairs (counted as one event) Swiss Pairs, Mixed Pairs, and the Barometer Pairs.

In total this covers 9 events.

B = Championship Teams

If 5 rounds or 17-32 teams, winning first round (2), winning second round (3), winning third round (4), winning semi (6), winning final (9) ie 24 points in total if playing in all rounds

VL awards only for rounds played e.g. A plays only in Rnd of 16 & Final gets 3 + 9, his replacement B in Rnd 2 gets 5 & replacement C in SF gets 7 VL pts.

C = Standard scale for one-off events and for the Championship Pairs Plate (at half scale)

Use C for: Mixed teams, Paul Jones, Swiss Teams, Mixed Pairs, Swiss Pairs, Ladies & Mens Pairs, Barometer Pairs, Championship Pairs Plate (at half scale)

*** Points are awarded down to half way, with equal blocks of 2 and 1 points from position 9 down to half way.

*** If the entry is below 10, there is no reduction in VL points.

The Trophy goes to the player with the largest total. A tie is broken in favour of the best average points gained per competition entered.
