A dozen of our members moved up in rank during April --John Kay, Laura Preston, Michael Schlessinger and Adair Wiess to Junior Master. Maria (Ietje) Dugard and Barbara Schmidt to Club Master, Barbara Haskell to Sectional Master, Stanca Ciupe to Regional Master. **Rosa Lin** to Life Master. Donna Walther to Bronze Life Master. Jim Cunningham to Silver Life Master, and Josef Blass to Gold Life Master. We're very proud of your accomplishments.

Our current active Unit membership is 491, down 3 from last month and down 4 from this time last year.

I've had several questions about what appears to be a delay in reporting rank changes. There usually is a two-month delay in my getting notification from ACBL. Some part of this has to do with the schedule for our clubs reporting master points earnings to ACBL -- their deadline for reporting points for a given month is the 10th of the next month. Let's say you're a Club Master (20 to under 50 master points) and ar-

rive at the Bridge Center on Tuesday afternoon, 5 May for the 199er game. You have to your credit and on ACBL's records 49.81 master points of which at least 5 are silver points which qualify you to move to Sectional Master when you reach the 50-point mark. That afternoon in a 12-table game you place and earn an award of 0.59. That bumps your master point total up to 50.40 but that award and any others won in club games for the month of May won't be reported to ACBL until 10 June and won't appear in my ACBL report until 1 July. I'm certain there's a similar delay in recording points for tournaments and other special events.
