We also thank **Patsy Whitehurst** for making the rented storage unit available to us. And as always, thank you to our many Unit members for their contributions to help defray the expenses for food and refreshments.

As we sum up the results of this past tournament, we already look ahead to 2010. The rental of a suitable venue has to be locked in within the next few months. As **Ron Adams** stated in his tournament report: "The choice of venue is a key factor in the

success of our event, both financially and socially." From past experience, the local high schools appear to be the only low cost option, but they are not without problems. Board members **Edy Bulthuis** and **Ken Dye** have offered to be our scouting committee to select a venue for next year's Sectional. ## BEWARE !!

I've mentioned before and hope our non-Life Masters have noted that ACBL is changing, its master point requirements, effective 1 January 2010 for one to become a Life Master. If you've received your August ACBL Bulletin, please study carefully the pink-tinted block at the bottom of column 3 on page 8.

If your dues-paid-through date is 12/31/09 or beyond, you're absolutely safe and not affected by the changes, provided you keep your membership active until you reach Life Master. That date is shown on the second line in the address block on the cover of your Bulletin -- to the right of your ACBL number. If you've lost, tossed, burned or loaned your Bulletin, there's still hope. Log on to [acbl.org](http://acbl.org) and follow the instructions. As a last resort, phone or e-mail me.
