Once again I remind our Future Life Masters (FLMs) that the masterpoint requirements for achieving the rank of Life Master changed as of 1 January 2010. Now one must have a minimum of 500 points rather than 300 and those must include the required number of color points.

A Future Life Master whose dues were current as of 31 December 2009 is grandfathered for the 300 minimum provided her/his dues remain current until she/he reaches the rank of Life Master. For those who joined ACBL 1 January 2010 or later and those who have allowed their memberships to lapse, the 500 minimum is required. If there are any questions about this, please let me know.
