## Learning to play Bridge with the York Bridge Club



#### **Fast Track Course**

with Chris Irvin

This is a 12 week course following the EBU 'Bridge for all' course. Full details of this are available on the EBU website: <a href="https://www.ebu.co.uk/education/bridge-for-all/programme">https://www.ebu.co.uk/education/bridge-for-all/programme</a>

#### Topics include:

What suits, tricks, trumps and scoring are, how the game is played, how to take the tricks in a simple no trump contract, drawing trumps and playing a simple suit contract. Defending a hand.

Open the bidding with a 1NT bid and make appropriate responses. Open the bidding with a suit (e.g. 1♣) and respond to the opening bid, Recognise whether this is a game or part score hand, Play a social game with friends or in a small friendly game in class

#### **Absolute Beginners**

with Ray Lyall

The course introduces bridge from scratch. No prior knowledge is assumed or required.

### **Topics include**

Bridge terms and rules explained.
Mini-bridge (learn to play bridge in 15 minutes!)
Play of the cards by declarer and defenders.
Bidding balanced and unbalanced hands.
Introduction to some bridge systems.

## **Consolidate & expand standard ACOL**

#### Topics include

Acol NT opening, Stayman & Transfers, NT responses & rebids, Weak 2s, Leading, Playing NT contracts, Opening strong hands, Overcalls, Doubles for takeout & responses, Losing trick count, Finessing and unblocking, Signals and discards, Slam bidding. Jacoby 2NT, Defence signals & discards, Unassuming Cue bid, Opening leads, 2 suited overcalls - Michaels & Unusual 2NT, RKCB, Splinters and cue bids, Doubling for penalty & takeout.

Use of stop card, Announcing bids, responding to requests for clarification from opponents, what to do if you don't understand a bid and calling the Director

#### Topics include

Play of the cards: No Trump and suit contracts. Opening leads and signals. Bidding: responder bidding, opener's and responder's rebid, invitational, limit and forcing bids. Competitive bidding inc. overcalls, negative and take out doubles. Response to 1NT/2NT inc. Stayman and transfers. Pre-emptive bidding, Slam bidding inc Gerber, Blackwood and cue bids.

# **Learn Through Play** with Ruth Roberts

Active learning while playing for fun. Ideally suited to those who want to move from social to duplicate bridge, returners to the game, people who prefer an active learning style by doing, or those who wish to practise and consolidate what they learn from other classes.

The emphasis is on analysis, understanding and development of play and bidding which arise from hands randomly dealt.

Topics are dealt with by request and can be discussed but are not the key focus of the sessions. The input of participants helps shape this course to their own requirements.
