OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
STYLE: NAT
Take out double – One suiter – 1NT = 15(+)-18H
Responses: 2 over 1: Forcing one round
2 over 2: Forcing. 3 over 1: Fit 4th + new suit 5th.
Level 3 = Weak. Cue = 11H(may be fit). Direct raise = Preempt.
-2 suiter: Responses: new suit: Nat forcing one.
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15(+)-18 HCP (After Pass: 4 M and 6 min.)
