Note 1: Unusual 2NT

(1C) – 2NT = Both Majors 5(+)H & 5(+)S

(1D) – 2NT = Both Majors 5(+)H & 5(+)S

(1H) – 2NT = Both Minors 5(+)C & 5(+)D

(1S) – 2NT = Both Minors 5(+)C & 5(+)D

Note 2: Michael's Cue Bid

(1C) – 2C = 5(+) Major & 5(+) D

(1D) – 2D = 5(+) Major & 5(+) C

(1H) – 2H = 5(+) Minor & 5(+) S

(1S) – 2S = 5(+) Minor & 5(+) H
