Jump new suit: Nat + FIT. Jump cue-bid: good raise
IN BAL. POS: Nat. shows less than good opening hand
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
16-18HCP ( After Pass/ 4 in the cheapest and 6 in the other)
IN BAL. POS : 9-13 HCP

ONE SUIT : weak

UNUSUAL 2 NT : 2 cue suits
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
DIRECT CUE-BID : 2 suiters but 1 ♣2♣: Nat
JUMP CUE-BID: asks for stopper for NT over 1♥/♠
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)</b>
2♣: landy → 2♦ : no preference
X: 4-3 (4) Maj + singleton minor      2♦ : Maj one suiter
2♥2♠: NAT + minor
IN BAL. POS : NAT X/ landy
