### **NOTE 1 – Michaels Cue Bid**

(1C) - 2C(1D-2D)

Both majors 5(+) / 5(+)

(1H) - 2H = 5S + 4/5 minor

(1S) - 2S = 5H4/ + 5 minor

All jumps in known suits are Premptive

Competitive bid – cue bid of opponents suit invitational or better in partners bid suit

# **NOTE 2 – Cappelletti**

### Over 1NT -

Double	Penalty with roughly 15+ points. (See also: <u>Gates Double</u> )	
2♣	A one-suited hand (any suit, normally 6+ cards) with roughly 11-14 points.	
2♦	At least 5-4 or 4-5 in hearts and spades, asks partner to correct to either major.	
2♥	At least 5-5 in hearts and a minor.	
2♠	At least 5-5 in spades and a minor.	
2NT	At least 5-5 in clubs and diamonds	

## **NOTE 3 – Splinters**

Opener's rebid 1 level above either a jump shift or a forcing reverse is a game-forcing splinter raise.

## Note 4: R K C B (4NT asks for 5 key cards, 4 Aces + King of Trumps)

Cue bid through to RKCB – both Kings and Aces

Responses:

5C = 3 or 0 5D= 4 or 1 5H = 2

5S = 2 + Queen of Trumps

5NT = 2 + a void

Responses to 5NT – lowest King

### **Note 5: Drury**

After an opening bid of one in a major in third or fourth position the partner's 2♣ shows 9/11 HCP and 3/4 card support.

#### Subsequent bids:

New suit from the opener shows a normal hand with proper opening values.

2 in the opening major is a sign off

### **Note 6: 1NT opening**

Responses – Jacoby transfers to Majors

2C – stayman as a rule but could be weak minor. – If weak, opener bids 2D -responder can pass or correct if weak

Minor suit stayman. –

Responder has game going hand with at least 4/4 in minors

If Opener bids 2NT (denying 4 card minor), responder can show M shortage next bid or bid 3NT
