2021-2022 NORTH AMERICAN PAIRS (NAP)
CONDITIONS OF CONTEST**

Addendum to Address District Final Contest

This document is to be used in conjunction with the D10 2021-22 NAP Conditions of Contest. That document had noted plans for a face-to-face district final contest. The sectional tournaments planned for those events have been canceled; the NAP district final will now be conducted online. This addendum replaces the 'District Level Competition section of the original CoC.

DISTRICT LEVEL COMPETITION

Note – participants in the District Final contest must have qualified at the club-level in qualifying games conducted June through August, 2021.

The District Finals for NAP Flight A and Flight C are planned to be held on-line (Bridgebase Online) on the weekend of January 22-23, 2022.

The District final for NAP Flight B Final is planned to be held on-line (Bridgebase Online) on the weekend of January 29-30, 2022.

Pre-registration and payment of district fees of \$40 per pair for each flight event in which the pair participates is required. This fee does not include that BBO session fee (expected to be \$3). Each pair shall provide an e-mail to the District Coordinator at jerryburford6@gmail.com, including the following information:

- Players names and ACBL numbers
- Players' BBO ids
- Specification of which flight (or flights) for which they are registering.

This e-mail should be sent by **January 5, 2022**. The pair shall also send a check in the required amount to the District Coordinator at:

The checks should be mailed so as to be delivered by **January 13, 2022**.

The number of sessions required for each flight's final contest will be dependent on the number of entries in each flight during the registration period. The contest for each flight will be a two-session play-through event (single day, Saturday) as long as there are 15 tables or fewer registered for that contest. If more than 30 pairs register for a flight, that flight will also include a third session on Sunday. The third session will be the top twelve pairs in that flight from the Saturday sessions. The times for each contest are presented below:

- The Flight A Final will be played on January 22, 2022 at 11am and 2pm; the ACBL Open+ Convention Chart will apply. If a third session is needed, it will be held on Sunday at 1pm CST.
- The Flight C Final will be played on January 22, 2022 at 11:15am and 2:15pm; the ACBL Basic Convention Chart will apply. If a third session is needed, it will be held on Sunday at 1pm CST.
- The Flight B Final will be played on January 29, 2022 at 11am and 2pm; the ACBL Basic+ Convention Chart will apply. If a third session is needed, it will be held on Sunday at 1pm CST.

The top three pairs in Flight A and the top four pairs in each of Flights B and C District 10 final will be eligible to play representing the District in the National final. The eligible pairs will be notified by the ACBL Special Events Coordinator regarding any subsidy earned based on their finish in the District final. Qualifiers must play in the national level event until eliminated to receive the award.

No new partnerships may be formed between the District and National level competition. If a qualifying pair is unable to attend the NABC, the invitation will be passed to the next eligible pair based upon its finish in the District final.
