Make sure you and your partner know – What’s Forcing,  
 What’s -Non Forcing  
 What’s – Invitational

Important tips on being competitive in the bidding:

- Hand Evaluation
- Judgement – Importance of shape
- Re-evaluating your hand when the opponents are bidding

Can never be pre-emptive actions by members of opposing sides on the same deal.  
 When the opponents’ bids show strength, consume spade with pre-emptive actions.  
 When the opponents’ bids show weakness, you need to be concerned with showing strength.
