

WHAT CAN I REBID

Let's consider some of the rebids we can make that tells your partner exactly what sort of opener you had ---minimum, strong, long suit, 2-suited, support for partner's response, etc.

Let's assume you have opened 1 diamond, and partner responded 1 spade, promising at least 4 spades and at least 6 HCP. Here are 5 of the most common rebids that you might make:

1. K62
J105

REBID 1 NT - This shows a balanced hand with 12-14 HCP, it also denies 4 card spade support.
2. QJ5

REBID 2 NT - This shows a balanced hand with 18-19 HCP. It also denies 4 card spade support and is NON-FORCING. Partner can pass if he/she has responded on 6 pts. Or even less. He/she can also rebid 3 spades with 5 (forcing) or 4 spades with 6, you have at least 2.

REBID 2D Don't rebid 1NT with this hand, it's not balanced. You can't rebid 2 hearts because that's a Reverse and promises 17+ pts. Rebidding 2 diamonds usually shows a 6 card suit, but there is no alternative to 2 diamonds with this hand.

REBID 3D Jumping in your own suit shows 15,16 points and a 6 card suit. Remember that it is NON-FORCING, partner will bid again with a good 8,9 or more points and will pass 3 diamonds if he/she has responded 1 spade with 5,6,7 or even a bad 8 points.

REBID 3C Don't jump to 3D, it's NON-FORCING and partner may pass. Don't jump in spades, partner may have 10xxx and you'd be in trouble. Don't jump to 2NT to show 19HCP, you have a singleton heart. Bid a forcing 3C, allows partner to rebid spades to show 5+ or bid NT with a heart stopper, if partner raises clubs, support S

REBID 3NT Rebidding 1NT or 2NT or 2D or 3C doesn't describe your opener. The only rebid that comes close is to jump to 3D. However, your hand contains 7 1/2 tricks because of the solid diamond suit. You have to realize the value of your hand that it contains 7 1/2 Running tricks. Surely there's a great chance that partner's Response can provide the other 11/2 tricks needed to make 3NT. When partner's responded, it's worth taking a shot at 3NT. The Jump rebid to 3NT shows this hand (with a running minor)
