Opening lead: J of hearts, what's your plan? If either black suit finesse works, you have 9 tricks regardless of which one you take first. How to plan the play assuming neither finesse works. The opponents keep plugging away at hearts. If hearts are 4-4, You will lose four tricks, 2 kings and 2 hearts – even if both finesses lose. If hearts are 5-3 with the opening leader having 5 hearts (the long hand), you have to knock out the entry to the long hand first. Duck the opening lead, win the 2nd heart and take the spade finesse into West which loses. He drives out your last heart stopper and remains with 2 winning hearts, but East, the short hand, has no more hearts, Now you take the club finesse into the short hand. If you take the club finesse into the short hand, you go down.

Opening lead, heart K. Win the Ace. Must play on diamonds before drawing trump. Lead a diamond from dummy, East echoes (showing an even number), West ducks and takes the 2nd diamond. Leads out his 2 top hearts, what do you do on the 3rd round of hearts? The natural play seems to be ruff high in dummy, but now it's impossible to draw trumps and reach the diamonds. If you try to cash diamonds before drawing trump, West will ruff and dummy's dead. Maybe you want to ruff the 3rd hearts low, East will overruff and return King of clubs. Again, you can't draw all the trumps and cash the diamonds. After drawing r rounds and ending in dummy, West still has a 3rd trump. What's the winning play on the 3rd round of hearts?
