The Expert Way to Bid to 3NT (not for mere mortals!)

In a recent match our opponents bid to 3NT, on the following hands, using a series of 7 bids, all artificial. However, there is a much simpler route!

North and South held:-

N: ♠ A86 ♥AK7 ♠A6 ♣KQJ94 **S**: ♠J73 ♥983 ♠K982 ♣A85 The bidding, with opponents silent, and ALL bids alerted went :-

N-S

$$3NT - (7) pass - (8)$$

Explanations below

- 1.**Various strong hands** most partnerships would open 2NT with a balanced 20 22.
- 2 Forced relay standard response following a 2*opening
- 3. **The "Kokish" relay** Shows a balanced hand OR a natural game going strong hand with a ♥ suit. This method releases the

2NT opening for various conventional meanings such as a minor 2-suiter. The Convention is named after its inventor, the Canadian expert, Eric Kokish.

- 4. Which is it?
- 5. **20 -22 balanced.** Opener would instead have bid any suit to show that suit and ♥s
- 6. 5-card puppet Stayman partner do you have a 4 or 5-card major?
- 7. No 4 or 5-card major.
- 8. Then we will play 3NT.

An interesting way to reach the final contract which you and I, as at the other table, would find by bidding 2NT-3NT.
