

<u>Hand 1</u>




• West opens 1C

- North uses Michaels cue bid 2C showing 5/5 in both majors & 6+ points (alerted)
- East has club fit & 6HCPs. He still raises to 3C
- South jump bids to 4H with a good fit, and his partner's known shortage in the minors

<u>Hand 2</u>



- East opens 1S
- South uses Michaels cue bid 2S showing 5 hearts & 5+ in an unspecified minor (alerted)
- West can't support partner & has to pass
- North with no fit in hearts, bids 3C to be passed or corrected
- South corrects to 3D




• West opens 1D

 North uses Michaels cue bid 2D showing 5+hearts & 5+spades (alerted)

 East jumps to 5D with a great fit – pre-emptive strike Check vulnerability


Hand 4



West opens 1D


 North uses Michaels cue bid 2D showing 5+hearts & 5+spades (alerted)

- **East** doubles with 10+ HCP, shortage in partner's suit & strength in opps suits.
- **South** with no fit in hearts or spades has nowhere to go & has to pass
- North can't play in 2DX so chooses one of his 5 card majors
- East doubles for penalties with 10+ HCP and such great holdings in the Majors




- West opens 1H
- North uses Michaels cue bid 2H showing 5+spades & 5+ in an unspecified minor (alerted)
- East bids 3C natural & forcing
- South pass
- West 3NT with stoppers in the other 2 suits

<u>Hand 6</u>




- West opens 1H
- North uses Michaels cue bid 2H showing 5+spades & 5+ in an unspecified minor (alerted)
- **East** bids **2NT** = 10-12HCP & stoppers in spades
- **South** pass
- West 4H




- West opens 1H
- North uses Unusual NT 2NT showing 5/5 in both minors & 6+ points (alerted)
- East passes
- South with a weak hand bids the longer of partner's two suits

Hand 8




- West opens 1H
- North uses Unusual NT 2NT showing 5/5 in both minors & 6+ points (alerted)
- East passes
- South with a weak hand bids the longer of partner's two suits



• West opens 1S


- North uses Unusual NT 2NT showing 5/5 in both minors & 6+ points (alerted)
- East bids 3S equivalent to a sound raise to 2S
- South makes a pre-emptive raise with a good fit – beware of vulnerability

<u>Hand 10</u>



- East 1H
 South pass
 West 1S
 - North 2NT showing 5+ cards in both minors (alerted)
 - East double with stoppers in both minors
 - South 3C chooses his better minor
 - East could bid 3H with
 6 cards or double for penalties check vulnerability

<u>Hand 11</u>



• West – 1D

 North - 2NT showing 5+ clubs & 5+ hearts (alerted)

- East 3D would have bid spades at 1 level but now supports partner's diamonds
- South 3H good fit for hearts
- West Pass
- North 4H strong hand & may even go on to slam with 4 loser hand & known heart fit
