# Trump Suit 1

Run the 9, then low to J.

Will lose out only to KQ  
doubleton.

# Trump Suit 2

Low to the 8, then low to the 9 if LHO plays low.

•K or Q singleton twice as likely as KQ doubleton.

# Trump Suit 3

Lead low to T, then low to Q. Avoid leading the 9 first as LHO may have singleton K or J.

# Trump Suit 4

No losers lead K then finesse J.

.Safety play for 1 loser only – lead A. Then the 6 covering East's card.

# Trump Suit 5

- For no losers, lead low and finesse the Q.
- For 1 loser, low to Ace, then lead up to QT. Saves a guess on 2<sup>nd</sup> round if East has J, K or KJ.

# Trump suit 6

.Finesse the 9 on 1<sup>st</sup> round. Best hope is that West has QTx(x) or KTx(x).

# Trump Suit 7

.Cash AK. When only missing 4 cards, a 2-2 break is more likely than West having 3 and East a singleton. If 1-3, it makes no difference.

# Trump Suit 8

- .For no losers, cash AK and hope that Q falls.
- .For 1 loser, safety play of A, then low to J.

# Trump Suit 9

.Play the partner of the pre-empter to have the missing honour.

# Trump Suit 10

.Looks like a complete guess for 1 loser only if the honours are divided, but extra chance if you play the K and East has a singleton Q. If you play the J and lose to the singleton A, you cannot catch the Q.

# Trump Suit 3
