## Passed Out or 6 Diamonds! by Jack Rhind

Hand evaluation has long been a critical part of success in bridge. High card points are easy, but what about distribution? Does your distribution work with the distribution of your partners hand? Here is an example of the importance of just such hand evaluation. It reared its ugly head in the round-robin stage of the 2022 Canadian National Teams Championships Group A which were played online at RealBridge.

## Kaplan Nuggets

Edgar Kaplan was not only one of our country's foremost players for half a century, he was also a leading bridge journalist and editor. And he was never shy about using a witty remark to make his point. The following quips come from various tournament reports he wrote between 1958 and his death in 1997.
"It looks as though the normal diamond lead will defeat the contract (...) However, it is no longer fashionable to lead partner's bid suit; West tried the ten of hearts instead. (...) Plus 600."
"At Table One, Granovetter, West, listened carefully to all the club bidding (it is hard to see whom South was showing his clubs to, if not to the defenders); he hit upon a club lead [ensuring two ruffs for the defense]"
"Rodwell bid a bold, brave four diamonds. Alas, the opponents turned nasty and doubled." ""You make two trumps", said declarer, Bergen, to Ross, West, showing his cards. "I’m not going to do anything stupid," said Bergen, in the process of doing something stupid, since he had claimed without considering the position if West should win and lead a diamond."
[A voluntarily bid grand slam goes down four]
"Yes, if you are going down in a grand slam, it's better to go down more than one -but there are limits!"
"Bramley, South at Table One, must have had two quite different reactions to his right-hand opponent during the auction: irritation, when [Sam] Stayman's delicate four-diamond bid presented an insoluble problem; then heartfelt gratitude, when Stayman indelicately sacrificed against the poor contract he had pushed the opponent into."
"In a way, it is a bonanza for a team to suffer disasters at both tables on the same board. Still, no one can afford many bonanzas like this one."
"Rotman-Glubok had a confusion over Roman key-card Kickback or whatever (O for the days when there were but four aces, and four notrump asked about them!)"
"Apparently, there was confusion over whether the king of diamonds should be counted as an ace on their auction, or only the king of hearts (how much simpler life was back then when there were only four aces instead five or six!). Obviously, the grand slam had no play."
"The diamond combination here is virtually identical to a suit discussed in the June issue from the Vanderbilt final. (...) You might think, then, that all declarers would get the suit right. No, unluckily, not one of them had yet received the June issue."
"South took advantage of the favorable vulnerability to give a preemptive jump raise; the vulnerability was favorable for North, too, so he added to the preemption. What could the poor Meckstroth and Rodwell do but double?" [They collected 1100]
[They languish at 3 C when 6 C is on]
"On the auction in the Open Room of the Women's, playing three clubs as nonforcing (...) has much to be said for it. Of course, whatever is said should be said to partner before the session."
"A decision like that five-heart bid can be justified only by success, and this one wasn't so justified."
