- [3] After 1 ♥/1 ♠-2NT, 3 of new suit shows strong 2nd suit. Bid at 4 level shows singleton/void
- [4] Michaels cue bid. Over a minor, shows both majors; over a major, shows other major and a minor.
- [5] Landy. 2♣=both Majs (5-4). 2♦ response=equal length or 3/2 and at least 2-2; 2NT if 0-0 or 1-1. 3♣=game invitational.
- [6] RKCB continued. After 5♣/5♦ response, next non-trump suit asks for trump Q. Trump bid says no; any suit bid says yes plus undisclosed feature in bid suit (usually a K, or singleton); 5NT says yes but with nothing more to say. After any response 5NT asks for specific kings: sign-off with none, bid cheapest if one or more.
