

Annual Meeting Questions and Answers

Question: When is the Annual Meeting?

Answer: Per the Club ByLaws, the Annual Meeting is held in January, at a date set and announced by the Board of Directors.

Question: Who can attend the Annual Meeting?

Answer: All members may attend the Annual Meeting.

Question: What business is handled during the meeting?

Answer: The election of Board members, any proposed amendments to the ByLaws, and other business as announced.

Question: Who can run for the Board?

Answer: Dues paid members in good standing can be nominated for the Board, either by the Nominating Committee or by at least ten (10) members in good standing and submitted in writing to the Secretary or other person designated by the Board of Directors on or before December 10 prior to the January membership meeting.

Question: Can incumbent Board members be re-elected?

Answer: Yes, however no member of the Board of Directors shall serve more than two consecutive full terms. A member who is appointed to fill a vacancy may serve for two consecutive terms after the partial term.

Question: How are incumbent Board members nominated for re-election?

Answer: While non incumbents seeking Director positions must be nominated either by the Nominating Committee or by at least 10 members in good standing in accordance with Section 4 of the ByLaws, incumbent elected Directors shall be re-nominated for a second term of office if they so request, without further requirement.
