

## Covid-safe Conditions of Play Summary - 220424

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The State Government announced a significant relaxation of the State's Covid-safety regulations to take effect from Saturday 23 April.

As a consequence our Covid-safe conditions of play are changing, although some Covid-safety precautions remain in place...

- Do not come to play if you have any Covid symptoms\*. Please get tested instead!
- **Vaccination – Proof of vaccination is no longer required!**  
This means that the club cannot guarantee that all players at a session will be – as a minimum - double vaxxed. However, the majority of our members are double- or triple-vaxxed and we encourage all members who are eligible for vaccination shots to take them if they can. (Some members are now (or will soon be) eligible for a second booster shot.)
- **Mask Wearing:** Unless you a close contact of a person has tested positive for Covid\*, wearing a mask when playing is optional. However, DHHS guidelines strongly recommend mask wearing where social distancing is not possible. You should wear a mask when playing if you feel at risk.

The club will continue to provide sanitizer dispensers at each table and we encourage players to sanitize their hands between rounds.
