

Covid-safe Conditions of Play Summary – 18 Jan 2022

- Do not come to play if you have any Covid symptoms. Go and get tested instead.
- Do not come to play if you have had contact with anybody who has tested positive to Covid. Follow DHHS guidelines on quarantining and getting tested and only return to play when the guidelines say that it is safe for you to do so.
- **You must be double-vaccinated^{1,2}** and you must be able to produce valid evidence of your vaccination status.
- You must submit to a body temperature check.
- You must check-in using the Service Victoria app.
- **You must wear a mask when inside the building.** Please be sure to bring a properly fitted face mask and wear it correctly, covering your nose and mouth.

Until further notice we will also continue to follow our Covid-safe playing measures...

- Lego Room density cap of 1 person per 2 sq m.
- Bring your own pen
- Sanitize hands between rounds
- North handles the boards, South handles the Bridgemates.
- Sanitize chairs and tables at end of session, etc.

¹If you are double-vaccinated and are now eligible for a booster jab, please get one. Your doctor and your local pharmacy are taking bookings, and you can book or walk-in to the Loddon-Mallee Vaccination Clinic in Mollison Street.

²The club has been advised by LGCC Management Committee that City of Bendigo now requires all users of its community facilities to be double vaccinated. This means that unvaccinated players will be denied entry to LGCC even if they hold a valid medical vaccination exemption certificate.
